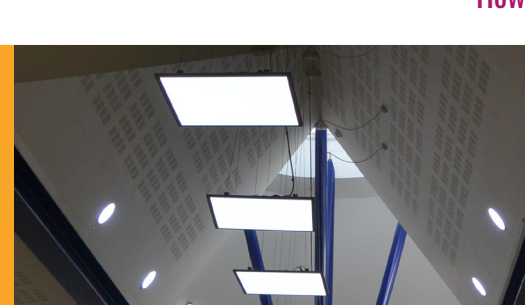
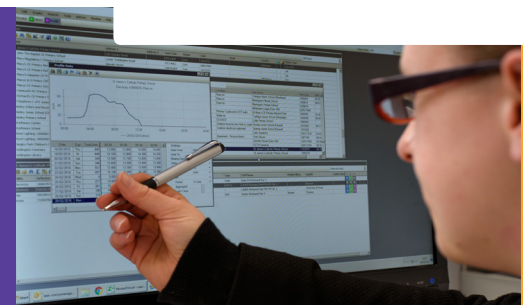

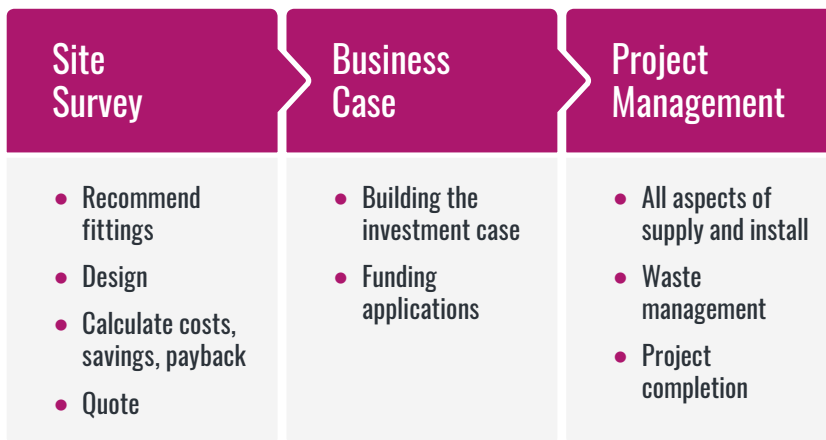
How to access the framework

There are two primary routes for accessing the framework, **Managed Access** and **Direct Access**.

1 Managed Access

Under the managed access route, LASER act as the contracting authority by managing the contract, supporting the end user to get maximum value from the framework, and deliver the best possible project outcomes. The supply and install is delivered through the framework as an OJEU compliant supply chain while the delivery is managed by LASER.

A typical project under the Managed Access approach is as follows:



2 Direct Access

Customers who wish to develop and manage their own projects may choose to access the framework directly. Under this option the customer is responsible for specifying equipment, agreeing pricing and managing all steps of project delivery.

About LASER

Kent County Council (KCC) is the 'Contracting Authority' for the LED framework contracts operated by LASER. The contracts are procured through OJEU compliant tender processes. KCC is a 'Central Purchasing Body' ('CPB'), as specified in the Public Contract Regulations 2015. As such, other public sector bodies are able to use the contracts in place without having to run separate tender processes.
